# Domaine de Trévallon rouge 1988

AOC Coteaux d'Aix-en-Provence Les Baux.

#### **PRESENTATION**

Trévallon is known for its long aging process, more than 2 years for its reds. Racking is kept to a strict minimum; the lees found at the bottom of the barrels continue to nourish the wine during the ageing process

#### LOCATION

North Alpilles

#### **TERROIR**

Limestone and clay soil, very stony: Hauterivian et Barremian, second stage of the lower Cretaceous, less than 130 million years

#### IN THE VINEYARD

Beginning of the harvest: 21 September. End of the harvest: 3 October

#### WINEMAKING

No de-stemming, yeasting or sulphur. Ageing 18 months in foudres and barrels. Fining with fresh egg white. No filtration before bottling.

### **VARIETALS**

Cabernet sauvignon 60%, Syrah 40%

#### **SERVING**

Decant before tasting and serve at 16°C. Aging potential of 25 years

#### TASTING

April 2005:Here is a wine which has taken time to open up. Over the last 6 months, it has burst open. It is difficult to predict how it will develop. At its peak in 3-5 years
