THE VINTAGE

2010 is a remarkably classic Bordeaux wine, combining aromas of red fruit, with great freshness on the palate, lots of silky tannin and astonishing intensity of colour.

TERROIR

Peyrosols and limestone

IN THE VINEYARD

All work favorizing a good distribution and aeration of the grapes (disbudding, clipping, thinning out of leaves)
Hand-picked harvest, followed by a manual sorting on clusters and then on berries.

VINIFICATION

Gravitary vatting without pressing
Prefermentary cold maceration
Long vatting period
Racks and returns

MATURING

15 months in barrels
40% of new oak

VARIETALS

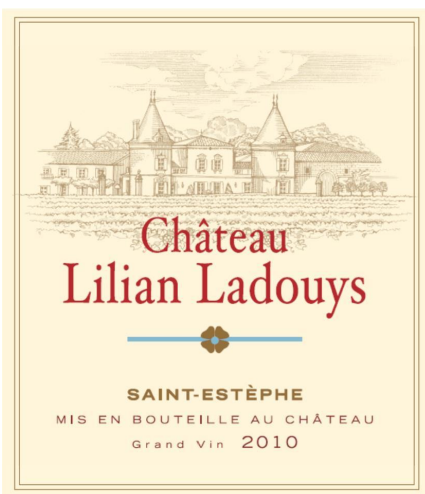
Cabernet-Sauvignon 60%, Merlot 40%

TASTING NOTES

Château Lilian Ladouys 2010 has a beautiful scarlet red with purple reflects. The nose reveals flavors of wood, humus and fresh fruits. After aeration, this wine shows us all of its complexity with peppermint notes. A voluptuous mouth and a full attack which exhibits notes of cakes like a strawberry cake.
