AOC Gevrey-Chambertin (Bourgogne)



PRESENTATION

Located halfway between Nuits-Saint-Georges and Dijon, the village of Gevrey-Chambertin is one of the villages of the Côte de Nuits known for its full structured wines. Our Cuvée comes from an assemblage of different climats and it reveals the full power of this appellation.

THE VINTAGE

The 2019 vintage brings back the magic of the "9" vintages in Bourgogne. A singular year with its share of stress, it ends with admirable wines of freshness and gluttony. The only downside is that the sharply declining yields have however led to very good concentrations which augur great wines for cellaring.

AGFING

12 to 18 months in French oak barrels of various capacities, ages and origins in order to smooth the impact of the wood as much as possible and allow a fair expression of the nuances of the appellation. No racking during aging and remassing for 2 to 3 months before to clarify the wines as naturally as possible.
