TERROIR

Ever since the Middle Ages vines have been planted on steep slopes facing south. The highest point is Mount Roti at 256m. The soil is composed of clay and limestone. Our vines are located on the localities known as BREZEME EST and BRESEME OUEST. The estate is currently planted with 3.5ha of red and 0.5ha of white.

THE VINTAGE

After the historically dry and hot summer, the wines give an impression of opulence, concentration and generosity. Ageing will allow the wines to soften and slowly find their balance.

PROCESS

Whole bunch vinification. 15 months of aging in 2-3 year barrels.

VARIETAL

Syrah 100%

TASTING

Deep and intense black colour. The nose is rich, with aromas of black fruit, hints of spice and black pepper. Ample and fruity in the mouth, it is particularly soft with mellow tannins and a persistent and very aromatic finish. This wine should be tasted within 5 years.

"Deep, vivid ruby-red. Displays vibrant, mineral-accented cherry and black raspberry aromas, along with licorice, allspice and olive paste nuances that add complexity. Sweet, penetrating dark berry, cherry and floral pastille flavors are underscored by a smoky mineral element and pick up a peppery quality on the back half. Fleshes out slowly on the clinging, sharply delineated finish, which is framed by harmonious tannins that blend smoothly into the wine's energetic dark fruit.
