

Saint-Joseph Bonneveau, Rouge, 2021

AOC Saint-Joseph, Vallée du Rhône, France



Colour : deep ruby colour

Nose : intense nose with aromas of fresh black fruits and menthol.

Palate : Very balanced wine. The notes of black fruits and zan dominate. The tannins are melted and delicate. Very nice persistence and minerality.

TERROIR

Plot situate on the heights of Tournon-sur-Rhône (350 m). Soil composed of light granite and gore.

WINEMAKING

Grapes are destemmed. Maceration in concrete vats (for a better thermic inertia) for about 4 weeks (depending on the vintage). Extraction made by pumping over and punching down.

AGEING

The barrel ageing lasts for 12 to 14 months in oak (10% new oak).

VARIETAL

Syrah 100%
