AOC Champagne Grand Cru, Champagne, France

Located in Villers-Marmery, next to the village Grand Cru Verzy, Champagne Sadi Malot is a family winery founded in 1883 by Socrate Malot and name after his brother Sadi, born the day of the assassination of French president Sadi Carnot. This 5 generation winery grows 10 hectares, planted with 80% Chardonnay and 20% Pinot Noir, farmed in organic and biodynamic since 2017.

TERROIR

Verzy I Grand Cru, LIEU-DIT "Les Goisses", chalky soil.

WINEMAKING

100% concrete tanks egg shaped, first press only. Malolactic fermentation done, no fining. Dosage : 5 gr/L

AGEING

4 years on the lees

VARIETAL

Pinot Noir 100%

Contains sulphites. Does not contain egg or egg products. Does not contain milk or milk-based products.

AGEING POTENTIAL

Enjoy all year long

TASTING

A champagne that marvelously expresses the power and elegance of our Pinots Noirs, with notes of spices, undergrowth, mirabelle plum and even pear. On the palate, it is rich and powerful, the texture is silky. The finish is persistent supported by a beautiful liveliness.

FOOD PAIRINGS

to be discovered with white meats and poultry in cream sauce, sweetbreads with morels, roast turkey, sea bass in a salt crust, langoustine with truffle jus, lobster in Bellevue, chaource, refined goat cheese.
