



Champagne Collard Picard

Champagne Collard Picard embodies the union of two emblematic winemaking lineages in Champagne, blending tradition with innovation. Founded by Olivier Collard and Caroline Picard, this family estate carries forward a multi-generational heritage while embracing a modern, exacting approach to viticulture. Located between the Vallée de la Marne and the Côte des Blancs, the vineyard spans 16 hectares, with plots in Cumières, Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, and Vertus. This geographic diversity allows for a precise and complementary expression of the three great Champagne grape varieties: Pinot Meunier, Pinot Noir, and Chardonnay.

The estate practices respectful viticulture, free from chemical fertilizers and herbicides, encouraging soil vitality and the vine's natural resilience. In the cellar, oak barrel fermentation—a true hallmark of the house—brings structure, finesse, and depth to the wines. Unlike many producers who favor stainless steel, this traditional method imparts a distinctive aromatic richness, blending brioche, dried fruits, mineral tension, and impressive length. Each bottle reflects a strong identity, the expression of terroir elevated by the winemaker's hand and the patient respect for time.
