The estate is reached by taking the "Route de Rozier," which winds through one of the most beautiful hillsides in Côte-Rôtie.

Historically a traditional mixed-crop and livestock farm, like most farms of the time, the production of appellation wines began more recently in the late 1980s.

Jean-Michel's father planted his first vines on family land (Les Rochins) and quickly acquired a few plots that were then fallow (Le Bourrier and Rozier).

The first bottles were produced in 1991, but the majority of the grapes were sold to local wine merchants.

In the early 2000s, older vines in the Fongeant and Janet vineyards were leased; the estate then comprised 1.5 hectares in Côte-Rôtie.

In 2004, Yoann joined his parents with the desire to expand the winemaking business, particularly the wine industry. This resulted in new plantings, the construction of a new winery, and the acquisition of new equipment.

In 2015, Erwan joined his brother.

-A dairy farm with 25 dairy cows and all associated crops for the animals' self-sufficiency on about fifty hectares of meadows, cereals such as wheat, barley, and corn. Some of the milk is processed into cheese and sold directly at local markets.

-The winery covers just over 6 hectares, primarily in the Côte-Rôtie appellation, but also in the Condrieu and IGP des Collines Rhodaniennes appellations. Some of the Côte-Rôtie vines are newly planted and are not yet producing.
