Terra Volubilis, Organic Côtes-du-Rhône, AOP Côtes du Rhône, Rouge, 2021

AOP Côtes du Rhône, Vallée du Rhône, France

Authenticity and diversity are the keys: Terra Volubilis (standing for the quintessence of terroir in latin) blends individual terroirs in mountainous northern granite vineyards and hilly, rocky soils in the south, all sourced throughout the highest quality level.

PRESENTATION

Charismatic and pure, this wine offers up a dark and concentrated CdR with unique finesse and balance. The complementarity of terroirs from both banks of the Rhône River evokes an exemplary expression of Grenache, richly flavored and generous. It's is not a single-estate wine but a perennial bargain because it retains a sense of freshness not often found in the Southern Rhône Valley.

WINEMAKING

Hand-picked, organically farmed fruits. Traditional vinification in concrete tanks, using low temperature fermentation (under 20°C / 68°F). Long after fermentation maceration in tanks for 2 to 4 weeks.

VARIETALS

Grenache noir 70%, Syrah 20%, Mourvèdre 10%

14,5 % VOL.

Contains sulphites. Does not contain egg or egg products. Does not contain milk or milk-based products.

SERVING

Hand-picked, organically farmed fruits. Traditional vinification in concrete tanks, using low temperature fermentation (under $20^{\circ}\text{C}/68^{\circ}\text{F}$). Long after fermentation maceration in tanks for 2 to 4 weeks.

TASTING

Subtle, fruity yet elegant, this richly concentrated red blend features distinctive green olive and peppercorn aromas alongside cherry fruit. It's silky and elegant on the palate. Effortless but concentrated, this organic wine is balanced by fresh acidity and fine, firm tannins, with a long finish. Terra Volubilis in its now available organic option is the perfect match for grilled meats, chicken and veggies on the backyard BBQ. It's that full body and spicy red taste that really makes the match.
