



Loire, Xavier Frissant, Tendance, AOC Touraine Amboise, Rosé

AOC Touraine Amboise, Vallée de la Loire et Centre, France

Xavier Frissant is a family winery, passed on 8 generations, composed of 15 hectares located on the slopes south of the Loire River, in the village of Mosnes. The vineyard expands on 5 differents hamlets and 2 different terroirs, and on 3 appellations: it has been organic since 2021. Maintaing healthy soils is the watchword in this estate!

PRESENTATION

From different plots of the Appellation Touraine Amboise.

TERROIR

Perruche (clay-with-flints).

IN THE VINEYARD

The vines, with soil cultivation, are in transition to organic certification. Goblet pruning.

Average age of the vines: 30 years.

WINEMAKING

Grapes were harvested mechanically just before being pneumatically pressed Alcoholic fermentation is done at low temperature about 30 days.

AGEING

Wine is aged on lees in stainless steel tank and bottled in March.

VARIETALS

Côt 70%, Gamay 30%

SERVING

12°C/54°F

AGEING POTENTIAL

2 to 3 years

TASTING

This well-balanced and fruity rosé offers freshness, it is a dry and soft rose in the mouth.

EOOD DAIDINGS

Marinated red meats or red meats with pepper sauce, cheese platter.
