



### Château de Rochemorin White 2018

AOC Pessac-Léognan, Bordeaux, France

#### **PRESENTATION**

The whites from Château de Rochemorin are astonishing wines. They reveal a particular expression of the Sauvignon grape variety, with its notes of citrus fruit and flowers, finely wooded. Carefully controlled barrel ageing on the lees does not leave its mark on the wines, but enhances the richness of the palate and supports a remarkable range of aromas.

#### WEATHER CONDITIONS

2018 was one of the warmest years since 1900, featuring above-average temperatures, the second hottest summer to date, and abundant sunshine… Heavy rainfall in the first half of the year was followed by persistent, near-record drought conditions in September.

#### **VARIETALS**

Sauvignon blanc 100%

#### ALCOHOL CONTENT

13.5 % vol.

#### **TASTING**

Pale-yellow colour scattered with silver highlights.

The nose is wonderfully intense, featuring aromas of yellow fruit (peach, nectarine) and lemon zest enhanced by hints of vanilla.

Starts out smooth on the palate. Roundness and volume are the two main qualities of this wine, displaying superb structure and balance between richness and freshness. Retronasal aromas of lemon zest follow through to the palate, accounting for the wine's impressive length and lovely freshness on the finish.

#### **FOOD PAIRINGS**

Ideal served with asparagus and smoked salmon, jumbo prawns in curry sauce or sea bream with lemon grass.

Serve between 9°C and 12°C
