We are implanted in Camaret-sur-Aigues, to the north east of Orange, in the zone of Rasteau. François Moricelly represents the fourth generation managing the family-owned vineyard, where cultivating vines is an integral part of the history of the estate.

PRESENTATION

In Provencal "Grand Destré" means "Large press": this wine press is still present on the estate. In between the two wars, it was used by François Moricelly's great grandfather to press grapes. The non fermented sparkling juice (bourru wine) was then immediately sold to restaurants in Lyon (bouchons) just before the arrival of the new wines.

TERROIR

Nature of the soils: clay siliceous, with stony outcrops.

IN THE VINEYARD

Average age of the vines: 40 years.

WINEMAKING

Direct pressing of the grapes followed by clarification then low-temperature fermentation.

VARIETALS

Marsanne 70%, Grenache blanc 30%

TECHNICAL DATA

Residual Sugar: < 3 g/l

SERVING

Ideal serving temperature: from 10°C to 12°C.

TASTING

Very light golden yellow colour with superb green hues. Very light and sweet nose. The first impression on the palate is fresh and fruity combining touches of lime fruit and vanilla.
