



Alsace, Domaine Loew, Pinot Gris Cormier, AOC Alsace, Blanc

AOC Alsace, Alsace, France

Domaine Loew is a family winery located next to Strasbourg. It was founded in 1996 by Etienne Loew, coming from a family with a rich history dating back to the 18th century. The estate of 6.5 hectares is spread out on 5 villages, with many various terroirs, but all the same subsoil of marl. Etienne is very attached to the protection of his land: the estate has been farmed biodynamically since 1996.

PRESENTATION

In the shade of a corm tree, this amphitheater-shaped parcel of red marl rests on a subsoil of Oligocene limestone.

TERROIR

Red marl, undersoil of limestone.

IN THE VINEYARD

Vines planted between 1985 and 1988, fully exposed North. Fresher plot in the winter and in the spring. Great exposure to the sun. Slow ripening.

WINEMAKING

Hand-harvested, indigenous yeasts only.

Harvested only in fruit days, according to the Biodynamic calendar.

Fermented all winter. aged on lees until summer.

VARIETAL

Pinot gris 100%

TECHNICAL DATA

Residual Sugar: 24 g/l

14 % VOL.

Contains sulphites. Does not contain egg or egg products. Does not contain milk or milk-based products.

AGEING POTENTIAL

Enjoy all year long, 5 to 10 years

TASTING

Rich, powerful and heady, this wine is dominated by pear and apple notes that enhance its body.

FOOD PAIRINGS

White meats, poultry, fruity desserts, foie gras.
