



Loire, Xavier Frissant, La Griffe d'Isa, AOC Touraine Amboise, Rouge

AOC Touraine Amboise, Vallée de la Loire et Centre, France

Xavier Frissant is a family winery, passed on 8 generations, composed of 15 hectares located on the slopes south of the Loire River, in the village of Mosnes. The vineyard expands on 5 differents hamlets and 2 different terroirs, and on 3 appellations: it has been organic since 2021. Maintaing healthy soils is the watchword in this estate!

PRESENTATION

A 1.10 hectare plot « Les Pierres » enjoying its location overlooking the Loire River.

TFRROIR

Perruche (clay-with-flints) very siliceous, selection of the best terroir.

IN THE VINEYARD

Natural grassing, organic certification. Goblet pruning. Average age of vines: 50 years. 35hL/ha yield.

WINEMAKING

After a hand harvesting, alcoholic fermentation begins for 21 days. Cap regularly punched down. Wine is aged minimum 12 months in 300L new barrels and 500L barrels of one wine. Bottled around July.

VARIETAL

Côt 100%

AGEING POTENTIAL

5 to 10 years

TASTING

With a deep purple colour, this powerful wine offers a peppery palate with silky tannins.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Prime rib of beef, meats cooked in sauce, a dessert with red berries and chocolate...
