Domaine Delhome is a family winery located in Larnage and is producing wine in the area since the 1900's, run by Gerard Delhome since 1993, joined by his son Romain in 2018. Together, they create the winemaking cellar in 2019 and converted the estate in organic viticulture: the 10 hectares are split between 20 parcels on the North part of the appellation, between 120 and 330 meters altitude.

PRESENTATION

At the estate, father and son prefer to make quality wines rather than quantity. Respect for the environment is a prerequisite for the optimal expression of the terroir and the production of unique AOC Crozes-Hermitage wines, and the two men are committed to

production of unique AOC Crozes-Hermitage wines, and the preserving the surrounding ecosystem.

TERROIR

From a granite slope, sheltered from the wind, facing south.

IN THE VINEYARD

Average age of vines: 4 years.

WINEMAKING

Whole harvest, direct pressing, low-temperature fermentation in temperature-controlled stainless steel vats.

AGEING

Aged on fine lees in stainless steel vats for 6 months, with malolactic fermentation.
