TERROIR

Clay-limestone terroir.

IN THE VINEYARD

Harvested at night to retain all the freshness and fruity aromas, direct pressing and temperature-controlled fermentation.

AGEING

Aged in vats on fine lees.

VARIETAL

Vermentino 100%

SERVING

Serve chilled, between 10 and 12°C. Enjoy this wine as an aperitif.

TASTING

La Belle de Canet reveals intense, expressive aromatic notes. The nose is marked by hints of flowers, pear and white peach, as well as a touch of ripe citrus fruit. The palate is soft and airy. La Belle de Canet is delicate and elegant.



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
