The Domaine Jean-Luc Mouillard is located in the village of Mantryn in the heart of the vineyards. Jean-Luc comes from a family of winegrowers and he has always felt this winegrowing fibre which has enabled him to develop his business over the years. 11 hectares of vines spread over three appellations: Château-Chalon, Côtes du Jura and Étoile. His estate is built on cellars dating from the 16th century, combining history and innovation.

PRESENTATION

For those who are reluctant to drink Savagnin under sail, here is the Curieux, a Savagnin not matured under sail, but aged in cask.

IN THE VINEYARD

Concerned about respecting the environment, this passionate winegrower is determined to use integrated farming methods in his various plots.

AGEING

Ageing in oak barrels for 18 months.

VARIETAL

Savagnin 100%

SERVING

To be drunk between 12° and 14° (54 to 58°F).

AGEING POTENTIAL

2 to 3 years

TASTING

A pleasant, mineral wine, with a nice fullness in the mouth.

FOOD PAIRINGS

To be served as an aperitif, with smoked fish fillets. Perfect Match: Avocado and smoked herring salad
