The Domaine Jean-Luc Mouillard is located in the village of Mantryn in the heart of the vineyards. Jean-Luc comes from a family of winegrowers and he has always felt this winegrowing fibre which has enabled him to develop his business over the years. 11 hectares of vines spread over three appellations: Château-Chalon, Côtes du Jura and Étoile. His estate is built on cellars dating from the 16th century, combining history and innovation.

PRESENTATION

This wine, made from the three grape varieties (Pinot Noir, Poulsard, Trousseau), has been aged in barrels for several months.

IN THE VINEYARD

Concerned about respecting the environment, this passionate winegrower is determined to use integrated farming methods in his various plots.

VARIETALS

Pinot Noir 50%, Poulsard 25%, Trousseau 25%

SERVING

To be drunk between 14° and 16° (58 to 62°F).

AGEING POTENTIAL

Enjoy all year long, 2 to 3 years

TASTING

Young, this trousseau expresses fresh, very acidic fruit. A very sapid, non-extractive, infused style wine profile for a 40 year old vine.

FOOD PAIRINGS

It is a perfect accompaniment to country terrine, grilled meats, quails, etc.
