Domaine Loew is a family winery located next to Strasbourg. It was founded in 1996 by Etienne Loew, coming from a family with a rich history dating back to the 18th century. The estate of 6.5 hectares is spread out on 5 villages, with many various terroirs, but all the same subsoil of marl. Etienne is very attached to the protection of his land: the estate has been farmed biodynamically since 1996.

TERROIR

Red mar

IN THE VINEYARD

10 to 40 years old vines, on slope exposed North. Slow ripening with freshness in the wines, not very vigorous vines.

WINEMAKING

Hand-harvested, indigenous yeasts only.

Harvested only in fruit days, according to the Biodynamic calendar.

VARIETAL

Gewürztraminer 100%

TASTING

The nose reveals peppery, floral and overripe aromas, which are confirmed on the palate. Full-bodied, with a hint of freshness on the finish.
