



# Loire, Xavier Frissant, Cot de Pierre, AOP Touraine Amboise, Rosé

AOP Touraine Amboise, Vallée de la Loire et Centre, France

Xavier Frissant is a family winery, passed on 8 generations, composed of 15 hectares located on the slopes south of the Loire River, in the village of Mosnes. The vineyard expands on 5 differents hamlets and 2 different terroirs, and on 3 appellations: it has been organic since 2021. Maintaing healthy soils is the watchword in this estate!

#### IN THE VINEYARD

Vines are certified organic, the grass cover is natural.

Age of vines: 12 years

#### WINEMAKING

After manual harvesting, the bunches are destemmed then pressed at using pneumatic pressing. Alcoholic fermentation lasts 30 days and aging in stainless steel vats until bottling in spring.
