MARRENON, Les Essentiels, Les Belles Echappées, Crucem, Crozes-Hermitage

AOC Crozes-Hermitage, Vallée du Rhône, France

The first vines on this terroir date back to ancient times. Its name comes from two place names: "Crozes", derived from the Latin crucem, meaning "cross" or "crossroads", and "Hermitage", from the Latin Heremitagium, which refers to the hill overlooking the Rhône on top of which the knight of Sterimberg, returning from the crusade against the Albigensians, settled to live.

PRESENTATION

This range reveals other expressions by exploring other characterful terroirs in addition to our historic appellations.

These prestigious appellations have been shaped and matured while retaining the hallmarks of our wines: elegance, richness and delicate tannins.

TERROIR

The Appellation develops over a vast terroir. It is an area of multiple convergences: rivers and climatic influences. The interplay of river deposits has created quite different soils, but terraces of rolled pebbles mixed with clay are the most widespread.

These complex situations can create capricious vintages, which is what gives this appellation its charm!

WINEMAKING

Traditional vinification. Little marc work to avoid rusticity. Short maturing period in oak barrels for several wines.

VARIETAL Syrah 100% Contains sulphites. Does not contain egg or egg products. Does not contain milk or milk-based products.

SERVING

Serve at 14°C.

AGEING POTENTIAL

3 to 5 years, 5 to 10 years

TASTING

In our blend, faithful to the styles of wines we like at Marrenon, we have tried to combine these expressions of fresh red fruit (blueberry, blackcurrant, redcurrant) and floral notes (violet).

ON THE PALATE

A style on the palate with a freshness that is coated and integrated into sensations marked by softness and roundness. Sculpted, taut but velvety on the palate, with fine tannins....

FOOD PAIRINGS

This red wine is the perfect accompaniment to chicken colombo, rack of lamb with herbs and jus, or truffle risotto.
