



Domaine Richaud, L'Ebrescade, AOC Cairanne, Red

AOC Cairanne, Vallée du Rhône, France

Established in 1960, this 60-hectare family estate is located in the heart of the Cairanne appellation. At just 17, Marcel took over his parents' legacy, leaving the cooperative to follow his own creative vision. Today, he runs the domaine with the help of his son, Thomas, and daughter, Claire. In the 1980s, Marcel expanded the estate by acquiring 3 hectares on the Ebrescade terroir, where old vines are planted on sediment, marl, and small stones from the Rasteau Massif at 250 meters in altitude.

LOCATION

L'Ebrescade » is made from old vines in the vineyard situated on the hilltop of Ventabren, at 327m above sea level: between Cairanne and Rasteau. The average age of the Syrah vines is 70 years and the Grenache and Mourvedre are 40 years.

TERROIR

The soils influenced by sedimentary mostly composed of marles and calcareous deposits.

AGEING

Aged for 24 months in old demi-muids and foudre.

VARIETALS

Mourvèdre 45%, Syrah 40%, Grenache noir 15%

Contains sulphites.

AGEING POTENTIAL

10 to 15 years

TASTING

Deep and dense red colour with ruby tinges. The nose and the mouth are dominated by jammy fruits, smoked flavors and spiced cinnamon. Tanins are concentrated and smooth. Beautiful roundness with a long finish.
