PRESENTATION

The estate is situated in Saint Philippe D'aiguilhe on calcareous-clay soils where Gilbert Gourraud produces wines with a dominant Melot variety. It is said that the famous French poet Alphonse de Lamartine may have paid a visit to this place a long time ago and this is how the vineyard got its name from...

WINEMAKING

Total destemming and sorting of the harvest. Before vinification, a cold pre-fermentation maceration is carried out, followed by punching down/pigeage and then about 3 weeks of maceration with temperature control. Aging for 18 months in concrete tanks before bottling.

TASTING
