An elegant, well-structured Médoc that truly reflects its terroir.



PRESENTATION

The name Laroche Clauzet has its roots in the local history of the Médoc. "Laroche" evokes the gravelly, stony soils characteristic of these terroirs, whilst "Clauzet" is an ancient surname from the South-West, recalling the families and localities that have shaped the vineyard over generations. The name thus reflects the wine's connection to its terroir and to the Médoc wine-growing tradition.

50% Sandy-Gravelly

Barrel

VARIETALS

Merlot 60%, Cabernet sauvignon 40%

Contains sulphites.

SERVING

Serve between 16 and 18 degrees

AGEING POTENTIAL

5 to 10 years

A beautiful ruby colour. The nose reveals notes of perfectly ripe red fruit. On the palate, it is generously rounded with silky tannins and a lovely length, enhanced by toasty notes.
