



Loire, Domaine des Ouches, AOC Bourgueil, Rosé

AOC Bourgueil, Vallée de la Loire et Centre, France

Domaine des Ouches is family estate of 18 hectares, that has been passed on for 8 generations, since 1743. Today, brothers Thomas and Denis Gambier runs the estate, located in Ingrandes de Touraine. The name "Gambier" came late in their history, as the estate was passed from mother to daughter for many generations.

PRESENTATION

The Gambier brothers try to make the most of their different plots. On the gravels, the soil warms up quickly and the grapes ripen more quickly. It's here that they produce their delicate rosé and their round, fruity red wines.

TERROIR

Vines planted on gravel terroirs.

IN THE VINEYARD

Mechanical harvesting.

WINEMAKING

This wine is a blend of Rosé de Pressées and Rosé de saignées. Fermented for 6 weeks at low temperature to preserve aromas.

AGEING

Aged in stainless steel tank for 4 months.

VARIETAL

Cabernet franc 100%

TASTING

Rose petal color. The nose is already very open with citrus fruit aromas and some white flower notes. The aromatic intensity is found in the mouth with a lot of freshness.
