THE VINTAGE

2019 vintage is in line with the top vintages of the decade. After a nice winter, spring came slowly, where our famous wind "Mistral" helped keep very healthy environments in the vineyard during that important growing season. The last week of June, Rhône Valley vineyards went through a heat wave with temperatures above 45° C (113 °F).

Fortunately, our biodynamic sprays of horn dungs, silicas, chamomiles, nettles and essential oils, combined with the good water reserve of the soils from 2018, helped the vines to continue their growth in great conditions. Thanks to August and September gentle rains we were able to pick beautiful grapes, healthy and balanced.

TERROIR

Châteauneuf-du-Pape is characterized by the diversity of its soils, with a mosaic of plots where different varieties grow together on limestone rock, round pebbles on a clay substrate with varying amounts of iron, and fine sedimentary sand.

IN THE VINEYARD

The grapes are hand-picked and sorted in the vineyard.

WINEMAKING

Long, gentle pressing and co-fermentation

AGEING

maturing in stainless steel vats, small foudres and oak barrels for 6 months.

VARIETALS

Assemblage des 6 cépages blancs de l'appellation, Clairette blanche & Rose, Grenache Blanc & Gris, Bourboulenc, Roussanne, Picpoul & Picardan

TASTING

This wine symbolizes our love for white Châteauneuf-du-Pape. We find delicate floral notes, a fresh and dynamic texture with a salty finish. Just like a walk in our Provençal "Garrigue".

FOOD PAIRINGS

Pressed red mullet with candied tomato.
