AOC Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Vallée du Rhône, France

### THE VINTAGE

2019 vintage is in line with the top vintages of the decade. After a nice winter, spring came slowly, where our famous wind "Mistral" helped keep very healthy environments in the vineyard during that important growing season.

The last week of June, Rhône Valley vineyards went through a heat wave with temperatures above 45°C (113°F).

Fortunately, our biodynamic sprays of horn dungs, silicas, chamomiles, nettles and essential oils, combined with the good water reserve of the soils from 2018, helped the vines to continue their growth in great conditions. Thanks to August and September gentle rains we were able to pick beautiful grapes, healthy and balanced.

### TERROIR

Châteauneuf-du-Pape is characterized by the diversity of its soils, with a mosaic of plots where different varieties grow together on limestone rock, round pebbles on a clay substrate with varying amounts of iron, and fine sedimentary sand.

### IN THE VINEYARD

Selected plots, of mainly old vines of the 13 varieties of the appellation planted together, predominantly Grenache.

### WINEMAKING

The grapes are hand-picked and sorted in the vineyard. Co-fermentation, long vatting for soft extractions.

### AGEING

Matured for 12 months in conical vats, foudres and barrels.

### VARIETALS

Assemblage des 13 cépages de l'appellation., Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre, Cinsault, Counoise, Muscardin, Vaccarèse, Terret noir, Roussanne, Clairette, Bourboulenc, Picpoul, Picardan

### TASTING

Made from old vines of different varieties growing together, with moderate yields, Boisrenard is characterized by the silky weave of its tannins and its generous fruit. A wine of immense depth.
