

# Olivier Ravoire

## FAMILLE RAVOIRE - Olivier Ravoire - AOC Côtes du Rhône Red 2024

AOC Côtes du Rhône, Vallée du Rhône, France

By naming this range in honour of the epic of Capitan Ravoire – a valiant knight in the 16th century in the Comtat Venaissin in 1593 - Olivier Ravoire was keen to highlight the history of the Ravoire family. In this respect, the different appellations have been named using terms associated with chivalry.

### PRESENTATION

Banderet, the name of our Côtes-du-Rhône vintage, is associated with the knight bannerets in the Ravoire family for several generations.

The vintage is the result of a meticulous blend of grapes from the best plots in the appellation. This wine was created to offer a rich tasting experience to share and discover.

### TERROIR

Clay-limestone

### IN THE VINEYARD

Average age of the vines : 40 years.

### WINEMAKING

The grapes are picked at the peak of their phenolic maturity, stemmed, and treading. This is followed by alcoholic fermentation at controlled temperature with mild regular extraction using pump-over. Vatting lasts approximately twenty days.

### AGEING

The blend is placed to mature for 10 months in concrete vats, followed by light filtering of the non-spliced wine.

### VARIETALS

Grenache 70%, Syrah 30%

### TECHNICAL DATA

Residual Sugar: < 2 g/l

### SERVING

Ideal serving temperature : from 16°C to 18°C.

### TASTING

Ruby red colour with garnet hues. Generous spicy nose balanced with aromas of red fruits. Ample and silky mouth feel, with pleasant melted tannins.
