AOC Gigondas, Vallée du Rhône, France

Situated at an altitude of 180 metres, the estate is surrounded by the hills and mountains that make the landscape of this region so attractive: to the south, the city of the Popes and the Dentelles de Montmirail, to the west, the valley of Nyons, or the theater of Vaison la Romaine. Today, the Domaine extends over 35 hectares around the village of Visan, one of the communes to have obtained the A.O.C. Côtes du Rhône Villages label as early as 1962. The 30-hectare vineyard is made up of a 15-hectare family

TERROIR

Clay limestone soils.

WINEMAKING

Destemmed grapes in raw concrete vats

AGEING

Aging in concrete vats.

VARIETALS

Grenache noir 90%, Syrah 10%

SERVING

16°C/61°F

AGEING POTENTIAL

2 to 3 years

TASTING

Intense red Black fruits and liquorice. Airy, very silky and melted tannins

FOOD PAIRINGS

Cheese with character, leg of lamb with thyme, barbecued rib of beef
