



# Château de Rochemorin Red 2015

AOC Pessac-Léognan, Bordeaux, France

### **PRESENTATION**

Château de Rochemorin belonged to the great philosopher and writer Charles Louis de Secondat, Baron de Montesquieu, in the 18th century. Among other famous works, he was the author of the "Persian Letters". Montesquieu was a fine ambassador for the red wines of Rochemorin among his friends, acquaintances and the notables he met during his trips throughout Europe, never forgetting to praise the beautiful complexity and mineral characteristics of his wine, so typical of the Graves terroir. Its beautiful aromatic expression, accompanied by a well-balanced and elegant palate make this one of the most reliable wines in the appellation, while remaining very affordable.

## THE VINTAGE

### WEATHER CONDITIONS

2015 was the third warmest year since 1900... Drought conditions, above-average monthly temperatures and sunshine (in the first half of the year), cool nights and hot weather in August accompanying véraison (colour change) were all ideal for the vines!

## **TASTING**

Lovely garnet-red colour with slight bricking. The enticing nose displays hints of slightly jammy red fruit (strawberry) and spice (white pepper). Beautifully balanced on the palate. Starts out quite soft and smooth, going on to display power, elegance, and a long fruity (morello cherry) aftertaste.

This Pessac-Léognan is perfect with roast beef, duck confit, and pork.

Serve between 15°C and 17°C
