The Domaine Jean-Luc Mouillard is located in the village of Mantryn in the heart of the vineyards. Jean-Luc comes from a family of winegrowers and he has always felt this winegrowing fibre which has enabled him to develop his business over the years. 11 hectares of vines spread over three appellations: Château-Chalon, Côtes du Jura and Étoile. His estate is built on cellars dating from the 16th century, combining history and innovation.

PRESENTATION

Savagnin, an original grape variety, is aged in barrels for a minimum of two and a half years.

IN THE VINEYARD

Concerned about respecting the environment, this passionate winegrower is determined to use integrated farming methods in his various plots.

AGFING

It is also aged under veil (yellow wine).

Savagnin 100%

SERVING

To be drunk between 12° and 14° (54 to 58°F).

AGEING POTENTIAL

Enjoy all year long, 2 to 3 years

TASTING

Powerful nose with aromas of nuts and curry. Pleasant to drink now or to let it age for a few years or to age for a few years for lovers of old wines.

FOOD PAIRINGS

To be enjoyed as an aperitif with cubes of Comté cheese, nuts, creamy dishes, fish. Perfect match: Coq au vin Jaune and morels.
