



Château Fontareche, Tradition, AOP Corbières, Rosé

AOC Corbières, Languedoc-Roussillon, France

Château Fontarèche, owned by the De Lamy family since 1957, is located in the Languedoc region, several kilometers far from Lézignan-Corbières. The estate makes a perfect square of 145 ha formed around the Château, which are under the appellation Corbières and Pays d'Oc, on a soil composed of pebbles stones: 17 grape varieties are cultivated in the vineyard. Experienced winemaker Vincent Dubernet was also managing Abbaye de Fontfroide prior to Château Fontarèche.

PRESENTATION

A unique blend incorporating Piquepoul Noir.

WINEMAKING

Short maceration after harvert. Pressing at cold temperature.

AGEING

Short aged in vat before bottling.

VARIETALS

Carignan 35%, Piquepoul 20%, Grenache noir 20%, Syrah 15%, Mourvèdre 10%

Contains sulphites. Does not contain egg or egg products. Does not contain milk or milk-based products.

SERVING

10°C/50°F

AGEING POTENTIAL

2 to 3 years

TASTING

Bright salmon pink color.

Nose of red fruits, strawberry, grenadine, slightly minty.

Suave and full mouth, with a very greedy fruit, low vinosity, and a fresh and airy finish.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Olives stuffed with anchovies.

Eggplant.

Pissaladière stuffed with anchovies from Collioure.
