



Champagne, Champagne Lagille, Grande Reserve, AOC Champagne, Effervescent Brut

AOC Champagne, Champagne, France

Located in Treslon, Champagne Lagille is family estate of 7 hectares, started in 1818, and run today by Vincent Lagille and his sister Maud Lagille. Their vineyard, mainly planted in Pinot Meunier, is in organic conversion since 2020 and is within walking distance of the cellar, enclaved in a natural circus (rather rare in Champagne!).

PRESENTATION

"The Grande Réserve will always be the "cuvée of my father". It's his favorite Champagne. In a way, I think that this cuvée tells his vision of Champagne "explains Vincent.

The only blend cuvée of the range, which is the most common in Champagne, combines structure and finesse. With a touch of tension representative of the Treslon terroir.

TERROIR

Clay and limestone.

WINEMAKING

Fermentation in stainless steel tanks and barrels, and aged on lees for 5 years before disgorging. Dosage: $6\,\mathrm{g/L}$

VARIETALS

Pinot meunier 33%, Chardonnay 33%, Pinot Noir 33%

Contains sulphites.
