



## Cornas Les Grands Mûriers, Rouge, 2023

AOC Cornas, Vallée du Rhône, France

*Colour: deep ruby core with purple tints.*

*Nose: aromas of very ripe fruits, raspberry and blackcurrant jam.*

*Palate: black berries, spices, sour cherries. A lot of tannins. Very long lasting wine.*

### TERROIR

A part of the vineyard is located on decomposed granite (called here "gore"), the other part on clay and limestone soil with alluvial sediments.

### WINEMAKING

Traditional, the grapes are partly destemmed. Punching downs are made twice a day. The maceration lasts about 3 weeks.

### AGEING

The wine is aged in oak barrels for 12 to 14 months.
