



Loire, Domaine Bernard Fleuriet, Anthocyane, AOP Sancerre, Rouge

AOP Sancerre, Vallée de la Loire et Centre, France

Since 1991, the Domaine Fleuriet has developed its own vineyards on 20 ha of sloping and fallow land belonging to the Sancerre appellation. The estate is representative of the typicity and diversity of the Sancerre region and the vines are present on the three great Sancerre terroirs (flint, caillottes and white earth).

PRESENTATION

From the oldest vines of the vineyard planted on great red terroirs, this wine is aged 100% in barrels. Thanks to reduced yields and a longer maceration, we obtain a full-bodied and powerful wine, with aromas of candied fruits and chocolate notes.

TERROIR

100% Terres Blanches (chalk)

IN THE VINEYARD

Sensitive to environmental concerns and a passion for quality, the Domaine no longer use weed killers on the farm and has been cultivating its vineyards organically since 2013 and labeled organic since 2016.

WINEMAKING

Maceration in whole cluster for 30 days.

AGEING

Aged in oak barrels (50% new oak barrels, 50% used oak barrel with one wine)
