## Burgundy, Domaine Piquet Girardin, AOC Meursault, Blanc

AOC Meursault, Bourgogne, France

Domaine Piquet Girardin was born from the merger of two estates, Anne-Marie Girardin's and Dominique Piquet's, both from families with deep winegrowing roots. Today, their son Damien takes over.

The domaine has grown with each acquisition. Today they cultivate 18 appellations on around 12 hectares of the finest Côte de Beaune vineyards, from Pommard to Maranges, via Meursault, Auxey-Duresses, Puligny-Montrachet, Chassagne-Montrachet and Santenay.

### PRESENTATION

Meursault is bordered from north to south and west by Volnay, Monthélie, Auxey-duresses and Puligny-montrachet. Famous for its centuries of history, Meursault produces great white wines of historic and international renown.

Meursault Village comes from 3 parcels: Limozin, Gruyaches and Vireuils  
Density: 10,000 vines/ha  
Exposition: south / southwest

### TERROIR

Terroir: Clay-limestone

### IN THE VINEYARD

Altitude: Average of 230m

### WINEMAKING

Stainless steel vat.

### AGEING

Aged 100% in oak barrels for 12 months, with regular batonnage (40% new barrels), this concentration of new barrels allows us to express the powerful, fat, gourmet character of these climates, like salt on racy meat.

### VARIETAL

Chardonnay 100%

Contains sulphites. Does not contain egg or egg products. Does not contain milk or milk-based products.

### SERVING

12°C/54°F

### TASTING

This blend has a golden color. The nose offers notes of ripe white fruit. The palate is round, complex and full on the attack. The finish is round and fine, with freshness, yellow fruit and almond, and a hint of minerality.

### FOOD PAIRINGS

Perfect with foie gras, creamed poultry or creamed fish.
