Beautiful property of 25 hectares located in the municipality of Valeyrac, near the Gironde estuary. It now belongs to Jérémy BAGAT, a winemaker representing the 4th generation of his family.

45% Sandy-Gravelly 30% Gravel 25% Sandy-Clayey.

AGEING

Stainless steel tank breeding.

VARIETALS

Merlot 58%, Cabernet sauvignon 40%, Cabernet franc 2%

Serve between 16 and 18 degrees.

Beautiful intense and deep color. A first nose releases notes of fresh fruits. After airing, spicy scents are added to the aromas of red and black berries, creating an interesting aromatic complexity. The palate is fruity and round with a nice tannic presence. A wine for pleasure to share.
