Domaine Fournier Longchamps is a family estate located in Rochefort sur Loire in Maineet-Loire: composed of 43 hectares of vines which spread out today on the appellations Savennières, Roche aux Moines, Anjou Blanc and Anjou Villages, Coteaux du Layon, Coteaux du Layon 1er Cru Chaume and Quarts de Chaume Grand cru. Their commitment is to respect and preserve the environment in order to favor the blossoming of the vine: the vineyard is certified organic and conducted following the biodynamic principles.

Terroir of sandstone schists and Aeolian sands.

IN THE VINEYARD

From vines that are 25 to 30 years old. Manual harvests, yield 30 hL/ha. Organic vineyard with biodynamic principles

WINEMAKING

Fermented and aged on fine lees in oak barrels for 9 months, and then 3 months in tanks. No malolactic fermentation.

2/L residual sugars.

Fermented and aged on fine lees in oak barrels for 9 months, and then 3 months in tanks.

VARIETAL

Chenin ou chenin blanc 100%

14 % VOL.

Contains sulphites. Does not contain egg or egg products. Does not contain milk or milk-based products

Enjoy all year long, 5 to 10 years

Aromatic notes, lively in mouth with a touch of salinity.
