PRESENTATION

This Côtes du Rhône Villages Plan de Dieu is the result of the rigorous blending of grapes from the best plots in the appellation. Enhanced through careful vinification and maturation, it reveals the potential of each of the selected terroirs. The cuvée was created to offer a tasting experience rich in conviviality, discoveries, and emotions.

TERROIR

Clay-limestone plateau with a top layer of rolled pebbles.

IN THE VINEYARD

Average age of the vines: 30 years.

WINEMAKING

Complete stemming. 20 to 25 days fermentation in concrete vats at 25°C.

AGEING

3 months in concrete vat.

VARIETALS

Grenache noir 70%, Syrah 20%, Mourvèdre 10%

TECHNICAL DATA

Residual Sugar: < 3 g/l

SERVING

Ideal serving temperature: from 16°C to 18°C.

TASTING

Deep red colour. Pronounced aromatic nose yielding fragrances of cooked cherries, garrigue and thyme. Frank and fruity attack with a pleasant structure.
