Located in the heart of the Saint-Pourçain appellation, and initially devoted to cereal crops, Olivier Teissède acquired the estate in 1976. In 1989, Olivier's wife, Odile, wished to diversify the estate's activities. That same year, they became owners of Clos des Béroles and planted the first 9,000 vines on the Climat des Béroles. Over the next 22 years, the vineyard developed to 8 hectares. In 2011, their son Jean joined to the family estate after training in Burgundy and the Loire Valley. He officia

HARVEST

Harvested by hand in 25 kg boxes.

WINEMAKING

Manually selected on a vibrating sorting table. Low pressure pneumatic pressing. Cold settling of the must (9°C)

12 months in 500L Allier oak barrels. No stirring.

Tressalier 100%
