



Loire, Xavier Frissant, Sauvignon Blanc, AOC Touraine, Blanc

AOC Touraine, Vallée de la Loire et Centre, France

Xavier Frissant is a family winery, passed on 8 generations, composed of 15 hectares located on the slopes south of the Loire River, in the village of Mosnes. The vineyard expands on 5 differents hamlets and 2 different terroirs, and on 3 appellations: it has been organic since 2021. Maintaing healthy soils is the watchword in this estate!

PRESENTATION

Plots located on the southernmost edge of the vineyard on lieux-dits $\rm ``Les$ Pentes $\rm ``and ``Les$ Hauts Noyers $\rm ``.$

TERROIR

Stony cliffside with clayish silica sand soil.

IN THE VINEYARD

Natural grassing, organic certification. Guyot pruning. Average age of vines: 20 years. 25hL/ha yield.

WINEMAKING

After the grapes were harvested mechanically and destemmed, they were pressed with pneumatic press. Vinification is done at low temperature for 30 days in stainless steel tank.

AGEING

Wine is aged on fine lees in stainless steel tanks before being bottled around January.

VARIETAL

Sauvignon blanc 100%

SERVING

12°C/54°F

AGEING POTENTIAL

2 to 3 years

TASTING

An elegant Sauvignon Blanc offering aromas of peach and citrus fruits. Fresh and mineral wine.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Platter of seafood, goat cheese.
