Mâcon-Villages

AOP Mâcon Villages, Bourgogne, France

PRESENTATION

This vineyard is located in the Mâconnais, in southern Burgundy, which differs from northern Burgundy, notably by its milder climate, but also by its vineyard, which is spread out over more than 80 municipalities along the hills and valleys.

LOCATION

Between the Côte Chalonnaise and the Roche de Solutré, the mountains of Mâconnais extend over about 40 kilometers, bordered by the Saône and the Grosne in southern Burgundy.

TERROIR

The soil consists of marls and sandy clays on a limestone substrate, hence a minerality often present in the wines of this appellation.

WINEMAKING

Traditional winemaking in temperature-controlled vats at 20°C. Aging on fine lees, 80% in vats and 20% in oak barrels for 8 to 9 months.

VARIETAL

Chardonnay

SERVING

Service temperature: between 11-13°C.

To be enjoyed young on the fruit or to be kept for 2 to 3 years.

TASTING

Pale yellow with bright silver reflections.

Fresh and floral nose, especially white flowers and a hint of licorice.

Round attack in the mouth and a slightly aniseed saline finish.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Classic pairing: Niçoise salad.

Unconventional pairing: Sea bass ceviche with mango and avocado.
