In southern Burgundy, near Chalon-sur-Saône, the village of Barizey is home to Sandrine Delétang et Fils, a wine trading company located in the Côte Chalonnaise. Its wine cellars have been modernised, with numerous vine plots on great terroirs having been purchased in order to expand the estate.

With grapes sourced from old vines on granit soils, this aromatic and round yet still fresh white benefits from warm summers, cooler nights and a little rain - the perfect combination to achieve a great maturation and express minerality.
