AOC Alsace, Alsace, France

Domaine Loew is a family winery located next to Strasbourg. It was founded in 1996 by Etienne Loew, coming from a family with a rich history dating back to the 18th century. The estate of 6.5 hectares is spread out on 5 villages, with many various terroirs, but all the same subsoil of marl. Etienne is very attached to the protection of his land: the estate has been farmed biodynamically since 1996.

PRESENTATION

First the Romans, then the hermits of the Bruderbach found an exceptional cru here.

TERROIR

Twenty-year-old vines located on the Bruderbach geological fault between the Sandstone and the Muschelkalk terroir (calcareous). The amphitheater-shaped, south-facing soil heats up quickly and stays that way for a long time. Plot of 1 hectare.

WINEMAKING

Hand-harvested, indigenous yeasts only. Nature wine.

Harvested only in fruit days, according to the Biodynamic calendar.

Fermented all winter with ageing on lees until summer.

AGEING

Partially aged in old barrels to aerate the wine.

VARIETAL

Pinot gris 100%

Contains sulphites. Does not contain egg or egg products. Does not contain milk or milk-based products.

Production volume: 150 to 250 cs Residual Sugar: 5 g/l

AGEING POTENTIAL

Enjoy all year long, 5 to 10 years

TASTING

Nose of hazelnuts and almond, full-body wine but not overly aromatic. Very structured, pure aromatic, gastronomy wine.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Delicious with meats in sauce or scallops with soy sauce.









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
