Domaine Loew is a family winery located next to Strasbourg. It was founded in 1996 by Etienne Loew, coming from a family with a rich history dating back to the 18th century. The estate of 6.5 hectares is spread out on 5 villages, with many various terroirs, but all the same subsoil of marl. Etienne is very attached to the protection of his land: the estate has been farmed biodynamically since 1996.

PRESENTATION

This wine comes from a stony terroir of upper Muschelkalk, fully facing west. Pure expression of terroir!

TERROIR

Bedrock of muschelkalck (calcareous terroir, sea-based limestone).

IN THE VINEYARD

Blend of 3 parcels planted between 1967 and 2007, on a slope facing West. High density plantation.

WINEMAKING

Yield never higher than 55hl/ha.

Hand-harvested, indigenous yeasts only.

Harvested only in fruit days, according to the Biodynamic calendar.

Fermented all winter. aged on lees until spring.

VARIETAL

Riesling 100%

TECHNICAL DATA

Residual Sugar: 4 g/l

12,5 % VOL.

Contains sulphites. Does not contain egg or egg products. Does not contain milk or milk-based products.

AGEING POTENTIAL

Enjoy all year long, 5 to 10 years

TASTING

If its bouquet suggests lemon zest and sugar-cooked lime, this wine stands out for its flinty character. A pure expression of terroir and stone!

FOOD PAIRINGS

Oysters, veal, traditional Alsatian dishes.
