AOC Pessac-Léognan, Bordeaux, France

PRESENTATION

"Couchiroy" or "Couche Roi" in Gascon. According to legend, one stormy evening, King Henri IV, returning from the Battle of Coutras, stopped here for a rest. This red Pessac-Léognan is easy-to-enjoy, smooth and fruity. It nevertheless displays the elegance and finesse typical of wines from this region of Bordeaux Graves. Château Coucheroy has classic blackcurrant and smoky aromas reminiscent of the atmosphere in a gentleman's club...

THE VINTAGE

WEATHER CONDITIONS

2019 was marked by a fairly mild winter, resulting in early bud break. Spring rainfall was scarce and drought conditions set in in early summer. Rainfall in August provided a welcome relief for winegrowers.

VARIETALS

Merlot 60%, Cabernet sauvignon 40%

ALCOHOL CONTENT

14 % vol.

TASTING

Colour is a deep garnet red.

Nose is intense and complex. After aeration, a tasty mixture of red fruits and vanilla notes emerges from the glass. A hint of spice enhances the whole.

The attack is frank. A nice volume emerges in the middle of the mouth, with well-melted tannins. The finish is very round. Notes of red fruit and liquorice dominate on the palate and bring a lot of gourmet pleasure.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Well-balanced, this is a wine that can wait a few more years or be enjoyed now, with lentil soup, tomato pie, or even baked beef.

SERVING

Serve between 15°C and 17°C

AGEING POTENTIAL

5 to 10 years

Gravel, clay sub-soil

19 years old

Pruning type: Double guyot with debudding

THE CELLAR

WINEMAKING

In stainless-steel temperature controlled tanks with patented cap-breaking system.

AGEING

For 12 months in barrels with racking each trimester.
