## **TASTING**

Pale yellow colour with golden highlights.

The nose is powerful and wonderfully complex, revealing delicious aromas of white fruit (green apple, pear), enhanced by a touch of lemon zest.

Starts out juicy on the palate. A very well-balanced, elegant wine with remarkable aromas. Vivaciousness and freshness are the watchwords here.

The mark of 2018, perceptible but really rather low-key acidity, is evident here though. Having said that, this is
