The 2022 vintage in Roussillon illustrates a year of climatic contrasts, with a marked summer drought and early harvests revealing concentrated grapes but in low volumes. Despite these challenges, the harvest has allowed for the production of promising, rich, and balanced wines, with an appealing aging potential.

TERROIR

High Terraces of Rolled Pebbles on Clayey Soil.

WINEMAKING

The grapes are macerated in different ways to extract the best from each grape variety. It is then a skillful blending by our winemakers that allows the full expression of this Roussillon terroir.

AGEING

In tank.

VARIETALS

Syrah 60%, Grenache noir 30%, Mourvèdre 10%

SERVING

Serve between 16°C and 18°C.

AGEING POTENTIAL

3 to 5 years

Deep red with violet reflections. Ripe red fruits and cooked fruits with a spicy touch. This wine offers a beautiful freshness, a beautiful minerality, and a beautiful length.
