The "J'peux pas j'ai Ventoux" vintage is a wine from a vineyard located in the Luberon Regional Natural Park, recognized as a Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO. In perfect harmony with its preserved environment, this wine embodies the balance between nature and humans. Cultivated with respect for the environment, 'J'peux pas j'ai Ventoux' captures the very essence of this exceptional terroir, offering a tasting experience that celebrates the richness and beauty of our planet.

PRESENTATION

Mount Ventoux, with its windswept slopes, is an iconic landscape of southern France and Vaucluse. This natural treasure represents an exceptional heritage to discover and preserve.

LOCATION

The plots of this Ventoux vintage are located in areas situated between 300 and 500 meters in altitude, with a southern exposure.

HARVEST

The harvest is carried out at an advanced stage of maturity, with complete separation of the grape berries from their stems. Gentle punching down is performed during the winemaking process. Additionally, the plots are cultivated in accordance with the principles of Organic Agriculture.

VARIETALS

Grenache noir, Syrah

SERVING

To be enjoyed between 12 and 14°C.

TASTING

The nose is full of intensity, velvety, with distinct notes of Morello cherries. The palate is enveloping and powerful with beautiful aromas of blackberries and a hint of gentle spices. The finish is crisp and fresh.

FOOD PAIRINGS

This wine will be the perfect companion to accompany a grilled beef fillet served with mashed potatoes or a Provençal ratatouille.
