AOC Champagne Grand Cru, Champagne, France

Located in Villers-Marmery, next to the village Grand Cru Verzy, Champagne Sadi Malot is a family winery founded in 1883 by Socrate Malot and name after his brother Sadi, born the day of the assassination of French president Sadi Carnot. This 5 generation winery grows 10 hectares, planted with 80% Chardonnay and 20% Pinot Noir, farmed in organic and biodynamic since 2017.

PRESENTATION

Unique expression of our Pinot Noir, rosé version.

TERROIR

Verzy I Grand Cru, chalky soil, conversion to organic/biodynamic viticulture.

WINEMAKING

Dosage: 5 gr/L

100% stainless steel tank, first press only. Maceration for 24 hours. Malolactic fermentation done, no fining.

AGEING

4 years on the lees

VARIETAL

Pinot Noir 100%

Contains sulphites. Does not contain egg or egg products. Does not contain milk or milk-based products.

AGEING POTENTIAL

Enjoy all year long

TASTING

To the eye, fine bubbles in the service and a ruby red color. An expressive nose opens with a profile of red fruit, cherry, blackcurrant and some strawberry notes. All the expression of our Pinot Noir. The mouth is fresh, greedy and balanced, we find all the aromas perceived on the nose.

FOOD PAIRINGS

ideal as an aperitif, perfect with antipasti, salmon in papillote, lamb chops, strawberry salad..
